REFUNDS - Full refund prior to Oct 1, after that no refunds (minus \$200 deposit)

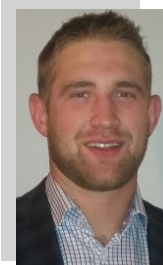

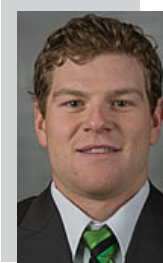
