

Publishing Student Work and/or Information

Light of Christ Catholic Schools believe education is a responsibility shared by the individual, home, school and community. To that end, it strives to provide a secure, stimulating, supportive and challenging environment.

The Local Authority Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (LAFOIPP) require that schools obtain informed consent for the collection and use of personal information that is not authorized under The Education Act 1995. This includes many situations within the student's school, Light of Christ Catholic Schools and within the community.

❖ Education Purposes in the School Community

- The school division will occasionally wish to share student information or student work specifically for purposes related to education and the school. The information and purposes for which it would be shared included the following:
 - Student's name, photo, team photo, candid or special event photos
 - School calendar, newsletter, or other school publications
 - Honors roll, yearbook, graduation, school related athletics and other activities
- Student work, such as: picture, audio or video presentations
 - For educational or promotional reasons
 - To display student work in the school
 - To display student work at school sponsored events

❖ Public Media Including the Internet

- There are times when the school may wish to share information with the media or publish it in a wider form such as on the internet. This may include the following types of sharing:
 - Photos of teams or others school groups
 - Photos of school events
 - Announcement of winners of awards
- ❖ In sharing this information the school will be very careful to balance the privacy interests of students and the inherent risks associated with posting of information in public or on the internet with the interests of students in sharing the pride of their achievements.

NOTE** Special situations may arise during the school year where a separate form may be utilized for parental consent.
